The undersigned agrees not to bring suit or other legal proceeding against said corporation, their agents, servants, employees or owners for any personal injury or property damage to the undersigned or others occurring on or about the premises of the above corporation or elsewhere. The undersigned further assumes full responsibility and liability for the conduct and safety of any minor supervised or brought to the premises by the undersigned.

The undersigned shall pay all costs and attorney's fees arising from any suit or legal proceeding which is brought by the undersigned, contrary to the terms of this agreement.

STATEMENT OF INHERENT RISK OF HORSES:

- A. The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in damages to property or injury, harm or death to persons on or around the equine. Such equine behavior includes, but is not limited to, bucking, shying, kicking, running, biting, stumbling, rearing, falling and stepping on;
- B. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movements and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- C. Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions;
- D. Collisions with other equines or objects; and
- E. Unpredictable or erratic actions by others relating to equine behavior.

SECTION 101.01 - PURPOSE AND SCOPE

101.01.01 - Purpose

The purpose of this section is to establish the minimum standards for the design and construction of all buildings and structures within the jurisdiction of the City of [City Name].

This section shall apply to all buildings and structures, regardless of their use, height, or area, and shall be enforced by the Building Department.

The Building Department shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this section and to issue orders, permits, and stop-work orders as necessary to ensure compliance. The Building Department shall also have the authority to suspend or revoke permits issued in violation of this section.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the authority of the Building Department to enforce any other provisions of the Building Code.

The Building Department shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this section and to issue orders, permits, and stop-work orders as necessary to ensure compliance.

SECTION 101.02 - DEFINITIONS

101.02.01 - Building
A building is any structure having a roof and walls, or a roof and floor, and is used or intended to be used for housing, shelter, or protection of persons or property.

101.02.02 - Structure
A structure is any building or other construction, including a bridge, viaduct, or other structure, which is used or intended to be used for any purpose.

SECTION 101.03 - PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS

101.03.01 - Building Permits
A building permit shall be required for the construction, alteration, or repair of any building or structure.

101.03.02 - Inspections
The Building Department shall conduct inspections of buildings and structures at various stages of construction to ensure compliance with the Building Code.
